

Instructions and Legal Requirements

1. The signers must be registered voters in Illinois at the time they sign, so you must ask if they are registered. A promise to register later is NOT legally sufficient.
2. They must include their complete address including their county so their registration can be checked by opposing candidates.
3. The signers must sign in the presence of the person gathering signatures, known as the “circulator” in the law. The petition cannot be left on a counter or tacked on a wall.
4. The circulator must be a US citizen and at least 18 years old.
5. After the signatures are gathered the circulator must fill out the bottom of the petition and verify that the statements there are true by signing before a notary public.
6. The signatures do not count unless the petition is notarized. It must be notarized.
